

**Students will be assigned to specific teachers later in the summer.**

### **Kindergarten**

2 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons or 1 box of 48 Crayola crayons, 8-10 large Elmer's glue sticks (pop off cap not screw cap), 1 package black only thin dry erase markers, backpack without wheels, lunchbox (if bringing lunch from home), sneakers for phys. ed. class/recess, headphones for media class (in a plastic zip-lock bag, labeled with your child's name), 1 folder for media class (label with name), change of clothing in case of accidents (Please leave in the bottom of your child's backpack -shirt, shorts/long pants, pair of underwear, and pair of socks). Please send in on the first few days of school in September.

### **First Grade**

GENERAL 2- large glue sticks; 3 boxes Ticonderoga #2 pencils; 1- hard, plastic pencil box for storage; 1- 1 inch binder, 1-12 count box of crayons; 1- 8 count box of thin markers; 2 thin, dry erase markers; 1 thick, yellow highlighter; 1 package of 3x3 Post it notes; 2 soft pink erasers; 1 small, clean sock OR dry eraser.; DURABLE, 2 POCKET FOLDERS: 1-blue, 1- purple, 1- yellow, 1- red, 1- green, 1 choice color.;NOTEBOOKS: 1 -black and white composition notebook with wide ruled lines, 1- spiral bound, unlined, 8 1/2 x11 sketch book. OTHER: headphones for media a Ziploc bag

### **Second Grade**

1- 1 ½ " binder (Writing Portfolio), 1 red single subject notebook (labeled Home Journal), 1 spiral notebook (child's choice) – labeled Reading (write name on), 1-black single subject notebook – labeled Math (write name on front), 1-green single subject notebook – labeled Writing (write name on front), 1 blue single subject notebook – labeled Word Work (write name on front), 5 two pocket folders (front pocket style for storing papers, durable plastic in the following colors: 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 color or design of your choice), 2 black dry erase markers, 2 pink rectangular erasers (write child's name on), 1 package of Post-It notes, 1-24 count crayons (write child's name on), 1- 8 count washable markers, 24 Sharpened Pencils (to share with the entire class), 2 big glue sticks, headphones(please put in a Ziploc bag), 1 backpack without wheels, container for crayons

### **Third Grade**

One dozen #2 pencils, two red pens, set of 12 thin magic markers or a 12 pack of colored pencils, 4 large glue sticks, yellow highlighter, 6 notebooks – math, science, social studies, WW, DOL, and an independent reading journal (Do not label any notebooks), 3 Folders – All folders should be plastic or be reinforced construction that are labeled "Take Home Folder" (Heavy Duty), "Library" and "Health". "Soft" pencil case to stuff into desks. No hard pencil cases please. Media headphones, 3 dry erase markers , \*\*Please label glue sticks, notebooks, headphones, pencil case, and highlighters with your child's name.

### **Fourth Grade**

4 one-subject notebooks: green-Science, black-Social Studies, your choice-Spanish, 3 three-subject notebooks: blue-Reading, purple-Language Arts, red-Math (wide ruled, spiral notebooks only please - anything bigger than

10 1/2" x 8" will not fit in the desks), 9 two-pocket folders: 1 green-Science, 1 black-Social Studies, 1 blue-Reading, 1 purple-Language Arts, 1 red-Math, 4 folders with pictures or patterns of your choice (Take Home, Health, Media, Spanish), 1 roll Scotch tape, 3 glue sticks, 1 blue or black pen, 1 red pen, 3 textbook covers (large), 1 eraser, 1 highlighter, 12 pencils (#2 only), crayons or markers, 1 package of loose leaf paper, 1 3in.x3in. Post-it notes, 2 black dry erase markers, enclosed pencil sharpener, pencil box (at least 1 inch deep to hold all pencils, pens, markers, etc), water bottle with closable top. Please have the following items available at home for homework: metric/standard ruler, pencils, loose leaf paper, Children's or Intermediate Dictionary. Special Area supplies for 4th grade: Spanish-index cards (3x5), Media-headphones labeled with name in a Ziploc bag that is also labeled (Headphones have been sent home. Please be sure they are working), Music-school recorder from 3rd grade is to be returned or \$5 for replacement. You may use supplies from previous years.

### **Fifth Grade**

**Math:** 5 subject notebook and folder (Please label MATH) ; **Social Studies:** 1 ½ inch binder, 4 dividers, loose-leaf paper (Label dividers: NOTES, HOMEWORK, TESTS/QUIZZES and WORKSHEETS. Put loose leaf in the notes section. Label binder as SOCIAL STUDIES.) **Science:** 2 inch binder, 5 dividers, loose-leaf paper (Label dividers: NOTES, HOMEWORK, TESTS/QUIZZES, WORKSHEETS, LAB WORK and put loose leaf in the notes section. Label binder as SCIENCE) **ELA:** 2 Three Subject Notebooks, 1 ½ inch Binder and 3 dividers (Label notebooks: Reading and ELA. Label dividers: Reading, Writing, and Vocabulary. You do not need loose leaf paper in this binder.) **General Supplies:** pack of pencils, pack of blue or black pens, ruler (cm and in), colored pencils or markers, 2 rolls of tape, scissors, 1 package of Post-it notes, 2 glue sticks, three book covers, pencil case, enclosed pencil sharpener. Please put the pens, pencils, tape, scissors, glue sticks, Post-it notes and pencil sharpener in the pencil case.

### **PE K-5**

All K-5 students should dress comfortably for movement, preferably in layers. Supportive, appropriate sneakers for movement and socks should be worn or brought into school on physical education days .

### **Media Supplies**

K-6 students will need headphones for media/classroom use. Please make sure the headphones are labeled with your child's name. Please put headphones in a large zip-lock bag also labeled with child's name. Headphones were sent home with students at the end of the school year. Please check to see they are in good working order. Headphones work better than earbuds for younger students. Please do not buy expensive headphones--we find that the Target \$5 bin headphones worked the best!

**Media K-4:** Folder of your choice. Feel free to reuse folder from last year if it is in good shape.
